



DNR 30-DAY PUBLIC NOTICE

The Department of Natural Resources serves the DNR 30-Day Public Notice in order to satisfy the requirements of the "Procedures Concerning Certain Licenses Act", IC 14-11-4, and its associated administrative rule, 312 IAC 2-3.

The DNR 30-Day Public Notice is published weekly to serve notice of the latest permit applications received at the DNR, Division of Water. This Notice can be viewed on the web at http://www.in.gov/dnr/water/ and can be provided by email upon written request. Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

- 1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
- 2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
- 3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
- 4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted. To request a pre-action public hearing, send the petition by email to water_inquiry@dnr.in.gov or by mail to:

Project Description: An earthen berm has been built along Pipe Creek and the UNT flowing into Pipe Creek from the west. A 205' section of berm along the UNT runs perpendicular to the floodway. There is a 833' section of berm running parallel to Pipe Creek. The berm measures 35' wide at the top and is approximately 16' tall. In addition, an existing pit

will be expanded into the boundaries of the floodway, resulting in 271,598 cubic yards being excavated.

Project Description: The bridge carrying Raymond Street over Pleasant Run will be rehabilitated (Bridge No. 49-3202F). The project work will include applying a rigid deck overlay, partial superstructure replacement, partial and full depth patching of the deck, patching of the raised median and replacing the existing timber boardwalk. The existing structure is a 3-span bridge that is 151.3' long with an out-to-out length of 93' and a max span length of 60'. The project will mill 0.5" of the existing deck and utilize hydrodemolition to remove all unsound concrete. A 1.75" rigid deck overlay will be applied over the clear roadway width. In addition to the rigid deck overlay, a 16' wide strip of reinforced concrete slab along the center of the bridge will be removed and replaced with cathodic anode protection. Drains will be removed and replaced, and patching on the underside of the deck will occur at all drain locations. Additional sub surface utility work will include excavating existing soil for TL-3 Test holes prior to installation of the drilled shaft foundations. A total of 0.002 acres of non wetland tree removal will be required. Permanent impacts will total approximately 0.328 acres for the placement of class 1 riprap and revetment riprap. Total temporary impacts will total approximately 0.016 acres for the use of 2 cofferdams that will measure approximately 182' by 2' by 2.75' and 177' by 2' by 2.75' dewatering equipment and a temporary construction access path.
