DNR 30-DAY PUBLIC NOTICE

The Department of Natural Resources serves the DNR 30-Day Public Notice in order to satisfy the requirements of the "Procedures Concerning Certain Licenses Act", IC 14-11-4, and its associated administrative rule, 312 IAC 2-3.

The DNR 30-Day Public Notice is published weekly to serve notice of the latest permit applications received at the DNR, Division of Water. This Notice can be viewed on the web at <http://www.in.gov/dnr/water/> and can be provided by email upon written request. To receive the DNR 30-Day Public Notice as a weekly email attachment, email your full name and a valid email address to DNRPublicNoticeRecipient@dnr.IN.gov.

Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted. To request a pre-action public hearing, send the petition by email to water_inquiry@dnr.in.gov or by mail to:

Project Description: A new ford/low water crossing has been constructed. Approximately 168 square feet of dirt was excavated on each side of the bank and placed outside the floodway. Concrete pieces were placed along the excavated banks and they are approximately 1' by 2' and approximately 4" to 6" thick. The approximate width of the ramps are 14' wide. The concrete pieces within the creek bed are approximately 4' by 5', and approximately 4" to 6" thick. The pieces within the creek extend approximately 35' from bank to bank.

The dredged area will be 185' long, 35' wide, and a maximum of 6' deep, removing approximately 1,440 cubic yards of sediment. The mechanical dredge will remove a maximum of 6' of sediment to restore the stream bed to a maximum depth of 8'. The project will leave a 5' shelf that will be slated to the lake 3V: 1H slope. The excavator will be placed on the road way and and load dredged material into sealed dump trucks. the dump trucks will haul the material off site and outside the floodway.

Project Description: A new group pier will be installed on Hamilton Lake. The pier will consist of two identical piers that will extend approximately 167' lakeward and will be perpendicular to the shoreline and 130' parallel to the shoreline. There will be four 24' long by 3' wide fingers that will extend off the main pier and parallel the shoreline. These piers will have two on each side and be spaced approximately 27' apart. At the end of the main pier a 130' long by 3' wide pier will be installed parallel to the shoreline. The parallel pier will feature 5 pier fingers that are 24' long by 3' wide. The group pier will feature parking for approximately 29 watercrafts. The 2 main piers will be spaced approximately 175' apart at their main perpendicular pier and spaced approximately 55' apart at the their longest parallel piers. The pier will be supported on 2" diameter augurs which will be placed in the lake bed using hand tools.

Project Description: The Division of Fish & Wildlife plans to install 30 fish habitat structures in Sylvan Lake to improve fishing and fish habitat. The structures will be made of natural hardwoods, metal screws, and will be weighed down using concrete blocks. The structures will be no larger than 4' by 4'. Structures will be placed in water depths sufficient to not pose a navigation or safety issue. The structures will be placed in minimum groups of 3.
