DNR 30-DAY PUBLIC NOTICE

The Department of Natural Resources serves the DNR 30-Day Public Notice in order to satisfy the requirements of the "Procedures Concerning Certain Licenses Act", IC 14-11-4, and its associated administrative rule, 312 IAC 2-3.

The DNR 30-Day Public Notice is published weekly to serve notice of the latest permit applications received at the DNR, Division of Water. Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted. To request a pre-action public hearing, send the petition by email to water_inquiry@dnr.in.gov or by mail to:

Project Description: This project involves the milling and resurfacing of Elm Street. The project will mill off 4" and replace with 1.5" surface and 2.5" intermediate. There will be no permanent change to the grade of the roadway within the floodway.

Project Description: CLV-29008 is a 24" diameter CMP that will be replaced with a 30" diameter RCP with revetment riprap at the outlet for scour protection. There are no changes to the road profile. There are no anticipated temporary impacts to water resources. There is no anticipated tree removal. Permanent impacts below the BFE of the Kankakee River floodplain due to the replacement of CLV-29008 and installation of revetment riprap (13.6 ft x 11.9 ft x 1.5 ft) with safety metal ends sections totals 0.006 acres and 14.8 cubic yards. INDOT plans to restore all non-wetland vegetation areas using INDOT seed mix R and all wetland vegetated areas with a native wetland seed mix.

Project Description: The existing twin bridges (49-1604F and 49-1605F) carrying West 38th Street over Little Eagle Creek will be rehabilitated. The existing structures are 190' long three-span prestressed concrete I-beam bridges. The bridge deck will be milled and unsound concrete on the deck, railings, and sidewalks will be removed via hydro demolition, and full-depth patching will be conducted where needed. A new 2¾ inch concrete overlay will be installed on the bridge deck. The concrete approach slabs and concrete median on the approaches will be replaced in-kind. The sidewalks on the approaches will be removed. Guardrails and guardrail transitions will be replaced where needed. Channel shaping will occur at the eastern toe of slope. Revetment riprap and Class 1 riprap will be installed at the banks. The existing structure dimensions and profile will not change. All temporarily impacted areas will be restored to pre-construction grade and vegetative conditions. There will be 0.108 acre of permanent floodway habitat impact. There will be tree clearing within a non-wetland forested area. Three (3) of the trees being removed from the floodway are greater than 10" in diameter. Mitigation will be done to compensate for the tree removal.

Project Description: A new seawall and new boat well will be constructed along the shoreline. The new vinyl seawall will extend along 15' of the shoreline and extend along 30' of the new dredged shoreline. The seawall will consist of 10' vinyl sheets anchored to deadman anchors extending 12' feet into the yard. The vinyl sheet pilings will be driven with 5' exposed and the area behind the wall will be backfilled with clean peastone (45' x 3' x 5'). A 30' x 15' x 3' water depth boat well will be dredged landward of the existing shoreline. The excavated material will be transported to an upland containment area for dewatering and disposal. The excavated material will be transported to 14512 County Road 44 Millersburg, Indiana for dewatering and disposal.

Project Description: An existing 92' concrete seawall will be recapped and refaced with concrete along 92' of the shoreline. The concrete reface will extend no more than 4" maximum off the top of the seawall and extend no more than 12" lakeward of the face of the existing wall. In addition to the seawall recap and reface an existing boathouse will have repairs. These include replacement of concrete wall sections. No expansion of the boathouse, no lakeward extension, no dredging, and no fill placement are proposed.
