The Department of Natural Resources serves the DNR 30-Day Public Notice in order to satisfy the requirements of the "Procedures Concerning Certain Licenses Act", IC 14-11-4, and its associated administrative rule, 312 IAC 2-3.

The DNR 30-Day Public Notice is published weekly to serve notice of the latest permit applications received at the DNR, Division of Water. This Notice can be viewed on the web at <http://www.in.gov/dnr/water/> and can be provided by email upon written request. Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted. To request a pre-action public hearing, send the petition by email to water_inquiry@dnr.in.gov or by mail to:

Project Description: Northern Indiana Commuter Transportation District (NICTD) proposes to construct an approximately 8-mile southern extension to the South Shore Line commuter rail line between the Town of Dyer and the City of Hammond, Indiana. The Project alignment crosses two waterways: the Grand Calumet River and the Little Calumet River.

Two bridges will be constructed over the Little Calumet River. The Monon Trail pedestrian bridge will be completely removed from its current location and relocated to the east, and a new rail bridge will be constructed at the current location of the Monon Trail pedestrian bridge. The new rail structure will be a 20' wide three span through girder bridge with a total span length of 234'-3" from the south end bent to the north end bent. The spill through abutments will have 2:1 sideslopes armored with limestone riprap placed over a geotextile fabric. The existing pedestrian structure will be completely removed and relocated to the east. The new pedestrian bridge will be 10'6" wide with a total span length of 236'-5.75" from the sound end bent to the north end bent. The project is federally funded.

Project Description: The bridges carrying I-70 over Brandywine Creek will be widened (DES2002600 & 2002601 (Lead DES 1702919)) The existing eastbound and westbound bridges are concrete continuous slab bridges on a 25 degree skew, that measure 151.6' long and varies in width from 54.6' to 57.54' and 75.1' to 81.44', respectively. The new bridges will remain concrete continuous slab bridges with no change in the length or skew. Each bridge will be widened by 25.16', eastbound will vary in width from 79.76' to 82.7' and the westbound will vary from 100.26' to 106.6'. Riprap will be placed on top of geotextile fabric at the spill slopes and around the piers for scour protection and bank stabilization. A total of 0.808 acres of floodway will be permanently impacted. Tree clearing will total approximately 0.077 acres, wetlands will have 0.663 acres of impact and the piers and riprap installed will impact 0.068 acres. Temporary impacts total approximately 0.6 acres and include the installation of a causeway, cofferdams, pump arounds and an access road. All temporary work will be restored to pre-construction conditions at the end of construction.
