DNR 30-DAY PUBLIC NOTICE

The Department of Natural Resources serves the DNR 30-Day Public Notice in order to satisfy the requirements of the "Procedures Concerning Certain Licenses Act", IC 14-11-4, and its associated administrative rule, 312 IAC 2-3.

The DNR 30-Day Public Notice is published weekly to serve notice of the latest permit applications received at the DNR, Division of Water. This Notice can be viewed on the web at <http://www.in.gov/dnr/water/> and can be provided by email upon written request. Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted. To request a pre-action public hearing, send the petition by email to water_inquiry@dnr.in.gov or by mail to:

Project Description: Hancock County intends to proceed with a trail extension project for the Pennsy Trail network to enhance connectivity, improve recreational opportunities, and promote the use of multi-modal transportation. The project includes bridge rehabilitation of an existing abandoned railroad bridge over Sugar Creek. The existing structure is a 133' long by 28.5' wide two-span steel plate girder bridge that was originally built around 1913. The project will include installation of a single new bridge deck, new steel bridge railings, concrete approach slabs, wooden handrail transitions, rehabilitation of the existing wingwalls, and concrete patching of the abutments and piers. A new 10' wide multi-use concrete trail will be constructed with 2' wide compact aggregate shoulders on either side. No scour protection will be installed. Approximately 0.40 acre of tree clearing is anticipated in the floodway.

Project Description: Two (2) collector wells with associated infrastructure will be installed. Each well will consist of a pump house and an adjacent building. The pump houses consist of a 40' diameter circular structure with twelve (12) 180' subterranean laterals. The top floor of each pump house will be 3' above the 100-year flood elevation. Adjacent to each pump house will be a 75' x 36' building constructed and elevated on fifteen (15) 3' x 3' piers. In addition, access paths to the collector wells will be constructed. The access paths are to be 16' wide with 2' shoulders on either side for a total width of 20'. Adjacent to the access paths, a subterranean 30" water line and overhead power lines will be placed. Approximately 13.7 acres of tree clearing will occur and will be mitigated for.

Temporary impacts will include the placement of two dewatering cofferdams and a temporary pump-around to provide a dry work environment during construction (INDOT Des No. 2201081)

Project Description: The existing County Road 300 South bridge will be replaced. The existing structure consists of twin corrugated metal pipe arches (CMPAs), each 24.4' long, 13' wide, and 8' tall. The new structure will be a single-span prestressed concrete bulb-tee beam bridge with a 70' span. The typical structure section will be sized to accommodate two lanes of traffic in each direction and a multi-use path on both sides in anticipation of the future expansion of County Road 300 South. To tie in the vertical and horizontal alignments, it is anticipated that approach work will be required east and west of the bridge. Approximately 0.55 acre of tree clearing is anticipated in the floodway.
