Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

Project Description: This bridge rehabilitation project (INDOT Des. No. 1800869) proposes removing and replacing the deck of the existing 91.5' long by 48.33' wide by 17.63' tall bridge carrying the roadway over the stream channel. No changes to the existing bridge dimensions are anticipated. The bridge deck will be milled 0.5" and hydrodemolition will be performed to remove unsound concrete. All hydrodemolition material will be maintained and collected to dispose of in a proper upland location. Full depth deck patching will be performed as needed. The deck will then be overlaid with a 2" thick Latex Modified Portland Cement Concrete Overlay or Silica Fume Modified Structural Concrete Overlay. In addition, Class I riprap scour protection will be installed around the bridge bents and turnouts. Total cumulative permanent impacts to the floodway includes 0.045 acre (69.03') for the placement of 132.01 cubic yards of fill materials (126.89 cubic yards of riprap and 5.12 cubic yards of pile encasement). Temporary impacts include the placement of two sandbag cofferdams to construct a temporary pump around, geotextile for construction access, and filter socks around geotextile. Each cofferdam is anticipated to be 6' long by 30' wide by 3' tall. Temporary impacts are anticipated to be in place for 60 days. Temporary impacts to the Arme y Ditch floodway will be restored to preconstruction conditions and seeded following INDOT Specification 621-R-697, using the Floodplain seed mix. Stream-bed impacts will be reshaped to preconstruction contours and native substrate shall be restored. No seed shall be placed within the stream.
