The DNR 30-Day Public Notice is published weekly to serve notice of the latest permit applications received at the DNR, Division of Water. ## Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

- 1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
- 2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
- 3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
- 4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted. To request a pre-action public hearing, send the petition by email to water\_inquiry@dnr.in.gov or by mail to:

Project Description: The Town of Zionsville proposes to rehabilitate the pedestrian bridge structure that carries Turkey Foot Trail over Eagle Creek. The project includes replacing the existing timber approaches with precast concrete panel boardwalk approaches. The two truss main spans will remain in-place. The work will consist of replacing the existing timber boardwalk approach sections with precast concrete boardwalk sections. The approach boardwalk will consist of approximately 5.5" thick precast concrete panels, approximately 11' by 1'-2" concrete beams, with a 10' clear trail width and 11'-3" out-to-out width. The grades of the approach sections will be set to not exceed a 5% longitudinal slope, maintaining or lowering the existing ground tie-in points. Since the proposed guardrail and railing at the approaches are not hydraulically obstructive, the approach section structure depth will decrease, and the natural flowline will be maintained, there will be no change to the flow regime due to this work. The proposed approach section structure depth will decrease from 1'-11" to 1'-7 1/2". The profile grade of the proposed approach boardwalk sections will be altered to a 5% longitudinal grade, and the tie-in points with the existing ground elevation will remain the same or be lowered. Project Description: Des. No. 2003023 project is to replace the existing structure and add riprap for scour protection. The new structure will be an 85', 1 -span continuous prestressed concrete hybrid bulb-tee beam bridge. Class I riprap will be placed around spill slopes and wildlife crossings and revetment riprap will be placed on drainage turnouts and wing side lopes for scour protection. Tree clearing will be necessary as a part of this project to reach the underside of the bridge. Tree clearing is expected at 0.24 acre below the Base Flood Elevation. Permanent impacts to Williams Creek will occur from fill below the BFE. Total permanent impacts below the BFE equal 0.084 acre and 250 cubic yards. Impacts within the floodway are the result of installing Class I and revetment riprap for scour protection on spill slopes and drainage turnouts.

Project Description: INDOT Des.#2100966 and 2100967 are associated with the rehabilitation of the existing bridges on State Road 63 over Little Vermillion River. The rehabilitation for both structures will include replacing the existing bridge deck, approach slabs, and bridge railings. Existing steel beams will be cleaned, coated, and made composite with the concrete deck. End bents will be converted to semi-integral, and minor patching will be performed on the substructure units. New concrete bridge rail transitions will be placed on the new concrete approach slabs, with approach guardrail and guardrail end treatments at the incoming and outgoing ends. Terminal joints with full depth HMA pavement will be installed at each end of the approach slabs. The existing approach roadway will be milled and resurfaced to transition back into the existing grade. The proposed profile of the roadway will match the existing. Revetment riprap drainage turnouts will be placed on the northeast corner of the NB Bridge and northwest corner of the SB Bridge. Debris in the channel at the upstream end of Pier 3 on the SB Bridge will be cleared. Overall permeant impacts below the BFE are 83', 0.03 acres and 90 CYS due to debris removal and drainage turnout installation. The temporary impacts below the BFE elevation will primarily involve construction access. Total temporary impacts below the BFE are 125', 0.067 acres, and 108 CYS. No temporary or permanent impacts to wetlands and no tree clearing will occur for this project. Disturbed areas below the BFE will be restored with seed mixture floodplain and above BFE will be restored with INDOT standard mulch seeding.
