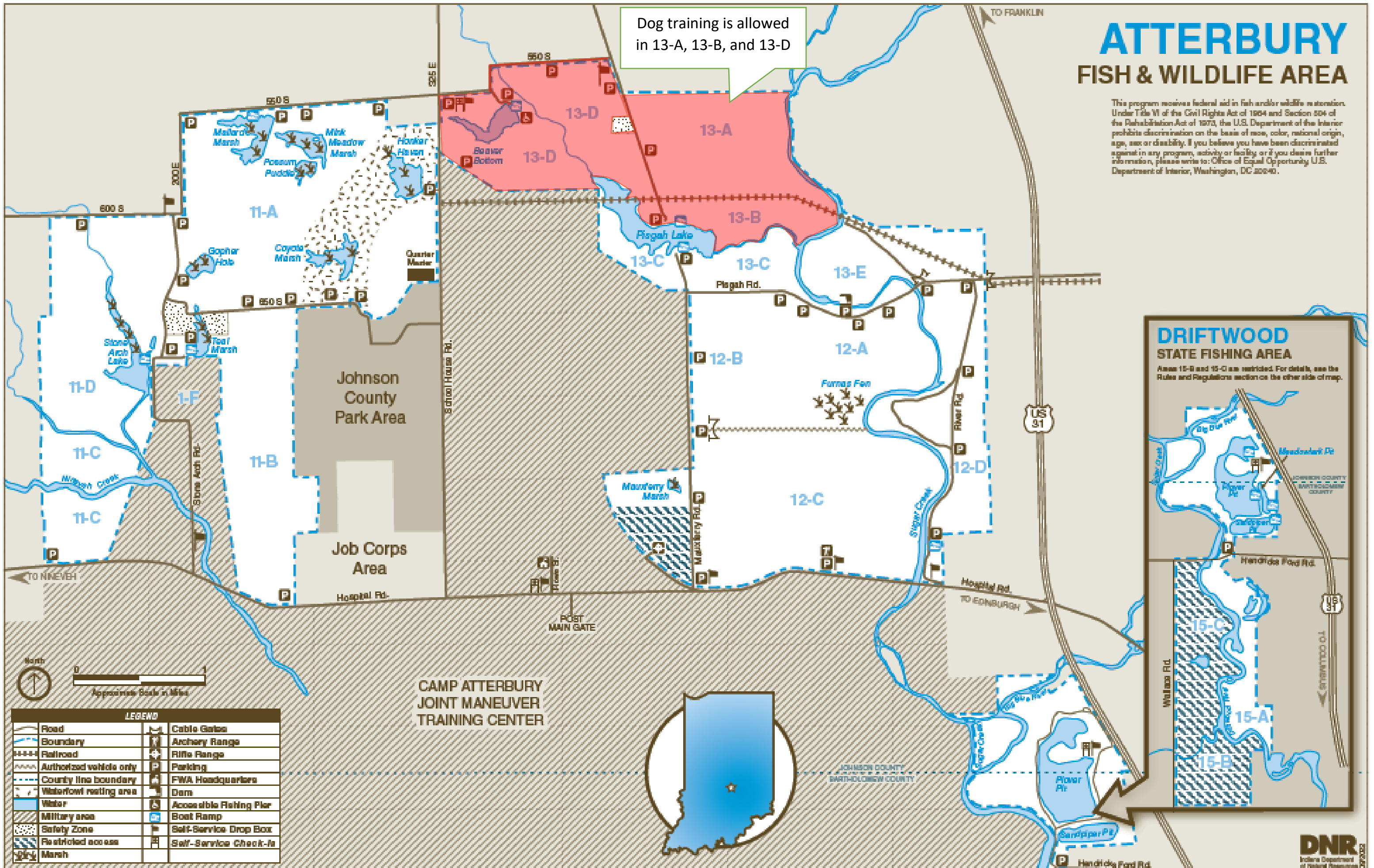


ATTERBURY FISH & WILDLIFE AREA

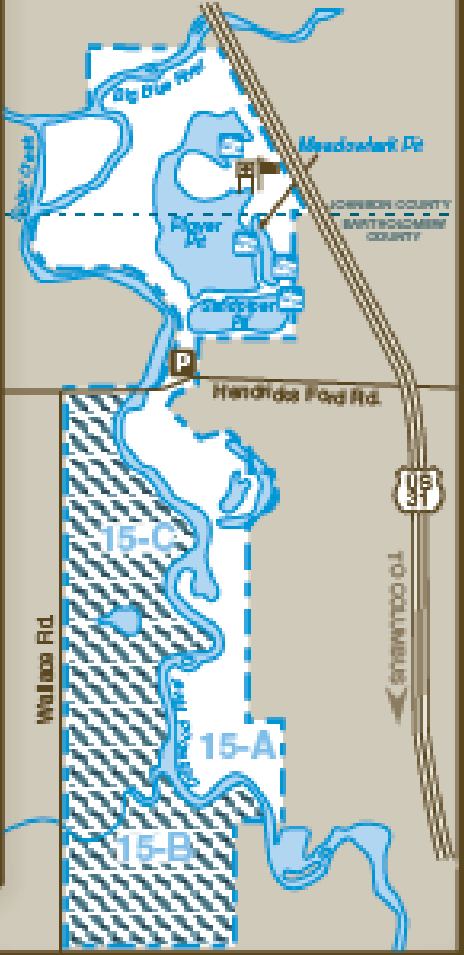
