To obtain an Indiana Fur Buyer's License, please mail a check or money order payable to the Indiana DNR with the application form and annual report (renewals only) or upload the form(s) and <u>pay online by credit card or PayPal</u>. Please note that there is an additional fee of \$1 plus 1.99% for the credit card fee to pay online.
