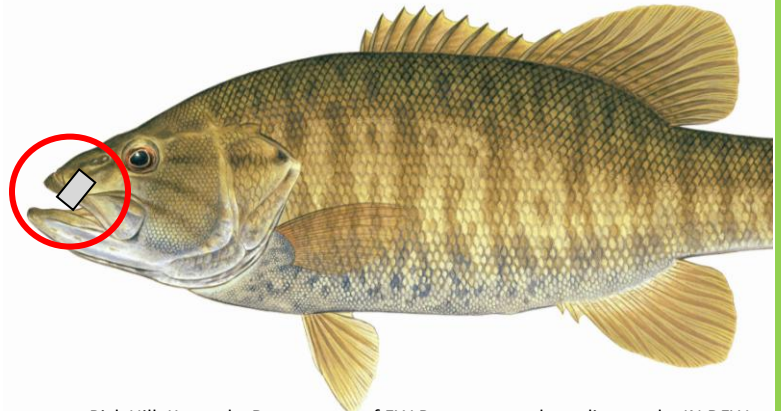


Caught A Tagged Black Bass?

Black bass have been tagged and released in the West Fork White River (Madison, Hamilton, and Marion counties), Eel River (Wabash, Miami, and Cass counties), and St. Joseph River (St. Joseph and Elkhart counties).

When you catch a tagged fish **contact IDNR (812) 287-8300** with the following information:

- Tag number
- Where the fish was caught
- Date caught
- Species
- Length
- Did you keep or release the fish?
- Would you have kept the fish if it were not tagged?
- If released, was the tag removed?
- Your name, address, and phone number.
- Do you want the tag returned to you?

Anglers may keep or release the tagged fish.

In order to receive your gift card; the tag must be returned to IDNR.

Why do we need this information?

IDNR will use tag return information to evaluate harvest, fishing pressure, and migration of black bass in these rivers.
