

## Conrad Savanna Deer Reduction Information

### Indiana Department of Natural Resources

A deer reduction hunt will be done under property rules by Indiana DNR at Conrad Savanna Nature Preserve in Newton County.

#### Hunt Dates:

- Firearms season: Nov. 16-Dec. 1, 2024
- Muzzleloader season: Dec. 7-22, 2024
- Archery season: Nov. 16, 2024-Jan. 5, 2025

**There will be no special antlerless firearms season.**

Hunters wishing to hunt the property must sign-in at LaSalle Fish & Wildlife Area and take a hunting permit card. Cards should be returned to a drop box located in the parking lots at Conrad Savanna. See map.

Parking: Hunters must park in one of the three designated parking areas at Conrad Savanna. Parking is limited and can fit about 12 vehicles. See map.

Successful hunters must report harvest information on their permit card and place them into one of the drop boxes on Conrad Savanna. See map for card box locations. Drop boxes are located at each of the three parking lots.

#### Rules:

- All legal weapons allowed on Fish & Wildlife areas may be used.
- No hunting is allowed between Beaver Lake Ditch and U.S. 41.
- **No bonus antlerless permits are allowed.**
- Deer Stands may be placed on the property starting Nov. 1, 2024 and must be removed by Jan. 10, 2025. All other DNR regulations regarding stands will apply.
