

Horseshoe Bend Wildlife Management Area

Horseshoe Bend Wildlife Management Area (WMA) is managed by Kankakee Fish & Wildlife Area (FWA) and is located near English Lake in LaPorte County, Indiana. This property totals 10.7 acres and is an oxbow still connected to the Kankakee River. It keeps a low amount of water year-round and stores water during flooding.

History & Amenities

Parking is located along C.R. 2300 S. on the north border of the property and along Millers Road on the east border of the property.

Access

No hunting is allowed on this property. Fishing is allowed on this property, subject to state and federal regulations. No check-in is required.

Prohibited Activities

Prohibited activities on this property include starting open fires, camping, swimming, digging, horseback riding, using ATVs or snowmobiles, dog running, hunting, and night hunting. Trapping is not allowed without written permission from the Kankakee FWA Property Manager. All state and federal laws apply.

Permitted Activities

Permitted activities at Horseshoe Bend WMA include:

- Foraging of berries, mushrooms, and nuts
- Fishing
- Wildlife viewing

Directions: Horseshoe Bend WMA is located just north of the Kankakee River and south of C.R. 2300 S. in LaPorte County. It is approximately 1 mile east of U.S. 421.

From English Lake, IN travel north on S. 650 W. and cross the Yellow River and the Kankakee River. Turn west onto W Bigler RD. Follow W. Bigler RD. for 1.5 miles to W. 2200 S. Take that road west to its end where it meets S. 875 W. Follow S. 875 W. south until you reach W. 2300 S., which follows along the property line of Horseshoe Bend WMA.
