

Round Lake Wildlife Management Area

Round Lake Wildlife Management Area (WMA) is managed by Kankakee Fish & Wildlife Area (FWA) and is located near Toto in Starke County, Indiana. This property totals 188 acres and is primarily comprised of a 33-acre lake, wetlands, prairie, and upland forest.

Amenities

There is a four-vehicle parking lot at the south-central side of the property. From the parking lot is a maintenance road that is mowed twice a year. The west side of the property has its boundary mowed twice a year for accessibility. There are no roads on the property. All off-roading is prohibited.

Access

Visitors can access the property by foot or boat only. There is no boat ramp. Boats are carry-in only. Round Lake WMA is located on C.R. 150 E. between C.R. 400 S. and C.R. 500 S. in Starke County.

There is no check-in for hunting deer (archer, muzzleloader, and firearms allowed), quail, pheasant, turkey, small game, crow, and frog. Waterfowl hunting has no check-in, except during opening weekend of waterfowl season, which will be drawn at the Kankakee FWA office. Only two waterfowl hunting parties are allowed at any time.

Hunters may use steel shot only, except for when turkey hunting. Only portable hunting stands are allowed. All other hunting is allowed within state and federal regulations. Electric trolling motors only. No hunting is allowed within the safety zone around the house located at the northeast corner of the property.

Prohibited Activities

Prohibited activities on this property include starting open fires, camping, swimming, digging, horseback riding, using ATVs or snowmobiles, using fuel-powered trolling motors, dog running, and night hunting. Trapping is not allowed without written permission from the Kankakee FWA Property Manager. All state and federal laws apply.

Permitted Activities

Permitted activities at Round Lake WMA include:

- Hunting per property rules
- Foraging of berries, mushrooms, and nuts
- Fishing
- Hiking
- Wildlife viewing
