## Tag instructions

- The person who killed the turkey must write the following information on this sample tag (or a piece of paper): their name, address, license number, date and sex of kill, and type of equipment.
- Cut this sample along the dotted line.
- Attach the paper to the leg of the turkey immediately upon taking and before it is transported from the field.
- The feathers and beard of a wild turkey must remain attached while the wild turkey is in transit from the site where taken.
- Turkeys must be checked at a turkey check station or through the CheckIN Game system within 48 hours of harvesting.
- Only bearded or male wild turkeys are legal game during the spring turkey season. A bird of either sex is legal in the fall season.
