
**2018-19 WATERFOWL SEASON
ATTERBURY FISH AND WILDLIFE AREA****ALL HUNTERS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE HIP PROGRAM****Ducks and Geese**

1. All hunters must return a one-day hunt permit card regardless of success.
2. Shot Shell limit is 25. Non-toxic shot required, maximum shot size: T
3. Daily bag limits and shooting hours: See the 2018-2019 Waterfowl Seasons and Regulations online (<http://www.in.gov/dnr/fishwild/>) or in the current Hunting & Trapping Guide.
4. Draw times: 6:30 AM EDT
5:30 AM EST (starts November 5th, 2018)
5. Drawing will be by computer run random number sheets.
6. Party size: 2 or 3. Singles will be considered after the drawing.
7. If drawn, parties may choose from available marsh areas.
8. Stakes-Geese only
Stakes are no longer in the draw.
Stakes are available on a first come first serve basis.
Duck hunting from the stakes is prohibited.
Shooting hours from the stakes are ½ hour before sunrise until sunset.
Hunters must hunt within 10 yards of the stake.
Guns must be left at the stakes when retrieving downed birds.
9. Ducks and Geese may be hunted from the following marsh areas:

Pisgah Lake, Furnas Fen, Teal Marsh, Beaver Bottom, Stone Arch Lake,
Mallard Marsh, Mink Meadow Marsh, Possum Puddle, & Mauxferry Marsh.

Maximum numbers of hunters per marsh:

Pisgah – 15
Furnas Fen – 3

Stone Arch – 6
Teal Marsh – 3

Beaver Bottom – 3
Possum Puddle – 3

Mink Meadow – 3

Mallard Marsh – 3 Mauxferry Marsh – 3

10. The waterfowl resting area, which includes Coyote Marsh & Honker Haven, is a restricted use area (no hunting, fishing or trespassing) from September 1 through the end of Waterfowl Season.

Pisgah Lake & Stone Arch Lake are open to fishing year around.

Beaver Bottom, Teal Marsh, Mallard Marsh, Mink Meadow, Possum Puddle are closed to fishing during waterfowl season, beginning October 27th.
