

**2018 MOURNING DOVE HUNTING
KANKAKEE STATE FISH & WILDLIFE AREA**

Only steel or non-toxic shot is allowed for dove hunting on this property – **50 shell limit per hunter per day.**

All hunters must have a **hunting license, HIP number** and a **state gamebird habitat stamp** to be eligible for the draw, except youth hunters on youth free hunting days (Sept. 1 and 2).

You may not possess lead shot while hunting doves on this property.

HUNTING HOURS

Noon to 5 p.m. CT, unless otherwise posted at the headquarters.

HUNTING ALLOCATION

A FIELD – 7, B FIELD – 15, C FIELD – 20, *D FIELD – 18, E FIELD - 19

Sept. 1: R3 event—any positions not taken by event will be open to youth hunters.

SEPT. 1

Hunting for 48 positions by reservation (61 total non-youth positions), standby drawing for unfilled positions at 11 a.m. CT.

SEPTEMBER 2 & 3

Hunting for 79 positions (48 reservations 21 by drawing on Sept. 2) at 11 a.m. CT. Drawings will be continued based on the number of hunters present each day at 11 a.m. CT.

When hunter numbers decrease below field capacity, self-service hunting will be allowed.

*R3 field will be open to non-youth after Sept. 1.



FIELD RULES

No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the fields.

Leave no trash in the fields—shotgun hulls are trash.

Be courteous to your neighbor—space out to a courteous distance.

Shoot only from the shooting strip toward the mowed area.

Do not shoot down the shooting strip or behind you.

Do not take your gun out into the field to retrieve birds.

Hunters must access fields through directed routes.

Some roads may be closed to traffic during hunting hours.

Park only in designated areas or lots. Do not pull off side of road unless specified.
