2016 September Waterfowl Rules and Information**

Goose Season – Sept 3-11 (Shooting Hours ½ before Sunrise to Sunset)

Teal Season – Sept 3-18 (Shooting Hours Sunrise to Sunset)

GOOSE DRAWING PROCEDURES

A drawing will be held at 4:30 AM the first day of the goose season. Upon completion of the hunt, a waterfowl harvest card shall be filled out and placed in a property drop box. All other days will be self service.

TEAL DRAWING PROCEDURES (SUBJECT TO CHANGE)

Drawings will be held every other day starting opening day at 4:30AM for teal hunting Blinds 11, 13,14,23,24,28,29,30. All other days are self-service for **Hunted Daily** areas only.

SELF SERVICE PROCEDURES

All hunters must sign and fill out all required information on blue waterfowl sign-in sheet. All hunters must take a blue daily permit card with them during the hunt. At the end of the hunt, the blue permit card shall be filled out and placed in a property drop box. Hunters may not sign other people in to hunt, and cannot sign in the day prior the hunt.

HUNTING SITES AVAILABLE FOR GOOSE AND TEAL HUNTING (SUBJECT TO CHANGE)

Hunted Every Other Day Starting Sept 3rd (Hunting Hours: Sunrise-Noon)

Baker Unit 11, 13, 14, 23, 24, 28, 29, and 30.

Hunted Daily

Blinds 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 31

Stakes Stake East, Stake West

Bayous State Line Bayou and White Oak Bayou

Area 5 P1, P2, P3, P4, P5, P6 are open to hunting. **All other ponds are closed to waterfowl hunting.** One party in Area 5 at a time

HUNTING SITES FOR GOOSE ONLY

North Side Bayous All bayous north of the river are goose hunting only. Area is also open for fishing and other activities. North Side hunting is self serve.
