



### **Bonus Antlerless Restrictions on DNR Properties**

Bonus antlerless licenses are NOT ALLOWED on the following Indiana DNR properties during the 2019-2020 deer season.

This includes bonus antlerless deer with a lifetime license, bonus antlerless license, resident youth hunt/trap combo license, or deer license bundle. The late antlerless season is NOT OPEN on these properties, regardless of whether they are in a county that is open. Please contact the property if you have any questions.

### **Youth Deer Season**

A youth deer hunter may take no more than one (1) antlerless deer during the youth deer season (Sept. 28 & 29, 2019) to count towards the bonus antlerless limit on the properties listed in this document.

### **Patoka Lake**

On Patoka Lake, except east of State Road 145 (in Orange County and Crawford County) and south of State Road 164 (in Crawford County), an individual may take antlerless deer only as follows:

- (1)** two (2) antlerless deer with legal archery equipment during the archery season in accordance with 312 IAC 9-3-4(c);
- (2)** one (1) antlerless deer with a legal muzzleloading gun during the muzzleloader season in accordance with 312 IAC 9-3-4(f); and
- (3)** one (1) antlerless deer with a legal firearm in accordance with 312 IAC 9-3-4(h) from December 26, 2019, through January 5, 2020.

### **Greene-Sullivan State Forest**

On Greene-Sullivan State Forest, an individual may take not more than:

- (1)** two (2) antlerless deer with legal archery equipment (bow and arrow or crossbow) during the archery season in accordance with 312 IAC 9-3-4(c);
- (2)** one (1) antlerless deer with a legal muzzleloading gun during the muzzleloader season in accordance with 312 IAC 9-3-4(f); and
- (3)** three (3) antlerless deer from October 1, 2019, through January 5, 2020 with:
  - (A)** archery equipment during the archery season in accordance with 312 IAC 9-3-4(c); or
  - (B)** muzzleloading gun during the firearms season in accordance with 312 IAC 9-3-4(e) and muzzleloader season in accordance with 312 IAC 9-3-4(f).
