<p>Comment summary:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Supports parts of plan that does not include timber harvests, and recommends this be extended to all parts of the plan.</li> <li>• Encourages control of Autumn olive using manual control methods only.</li> <li>• Recommends the loblolly and white pine plantations be allowed to die naturally (rather than the prescribed thinning) and re-evaluate in 2030.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The prescribed management activities are consistent with silvicultural principles and supported by inventory data and field assessments.</li> <li>• A variety of control options (manual and chemical) will be evaluated for controlling Autumn olive in the tract. Any herbicides used will be used in accordance with the product label.</li> <li>• The concerns expressed have been considered and may be further addressed during plan implementation.</li> </ul>
