#### How to Participate

- 1. Attend four interpretive programs, participate in three volunteer activities, and complete required activities listed in this brochure.
- Each time you finish a requirement, have the property's interpreter sign and date your report card.
- 3. Finish all requirements and turn in your report card to get a Challenge Patch for the suggested donation of \$1 to help offset program costs.

Each person must complete his or her own requirements to earn a patch. There are no age limits, as long as the individual working on the patch completes the work. People of all abilities are welcome to participate.

The Challenge Patch is part of the Indiana State Park Hoosier Quest Series, which also includes a Discover patch and the Explore pin program.
