SNOWMOBILE TRAIL REGULATIONS

- Trails are open from December 1 to March 31 only when trails are posted as "OPEN."
- The use of trails by wheeled vehicles is prohibited.
- All snowmobiles must be registered.
- All Indiana Snowmobile laws (IC 14-16-1) must be obeyed.

Emergency markers are located throughout the trail to assist trail users with contact and location information in the event of an emergency.


State snowmobile trails are located on leased trail easements across private property.

DO NOT LEAVE THE MARKED TRAIL

Snowmobiling on county roads is allowed in some counties by local ordinance. The sheriff's office of each county can provide information on its snowmobiling laws. All road laws, including holding a valid driver's license, must be obeyed.
