

Consideration of the dedication of the Wilbur Wright Nature Preserve in Henry County

This proposed nature preserve is located in Henry County within the Tipton Till Plain natural region.

It was acquired by the Indiana Department of Natural Resources in 1972. The 151-acre area contains mesic upland forest and floodplain forest along the Little Blue River and is part of Wilbur Wright Fish & Wildlife Area.

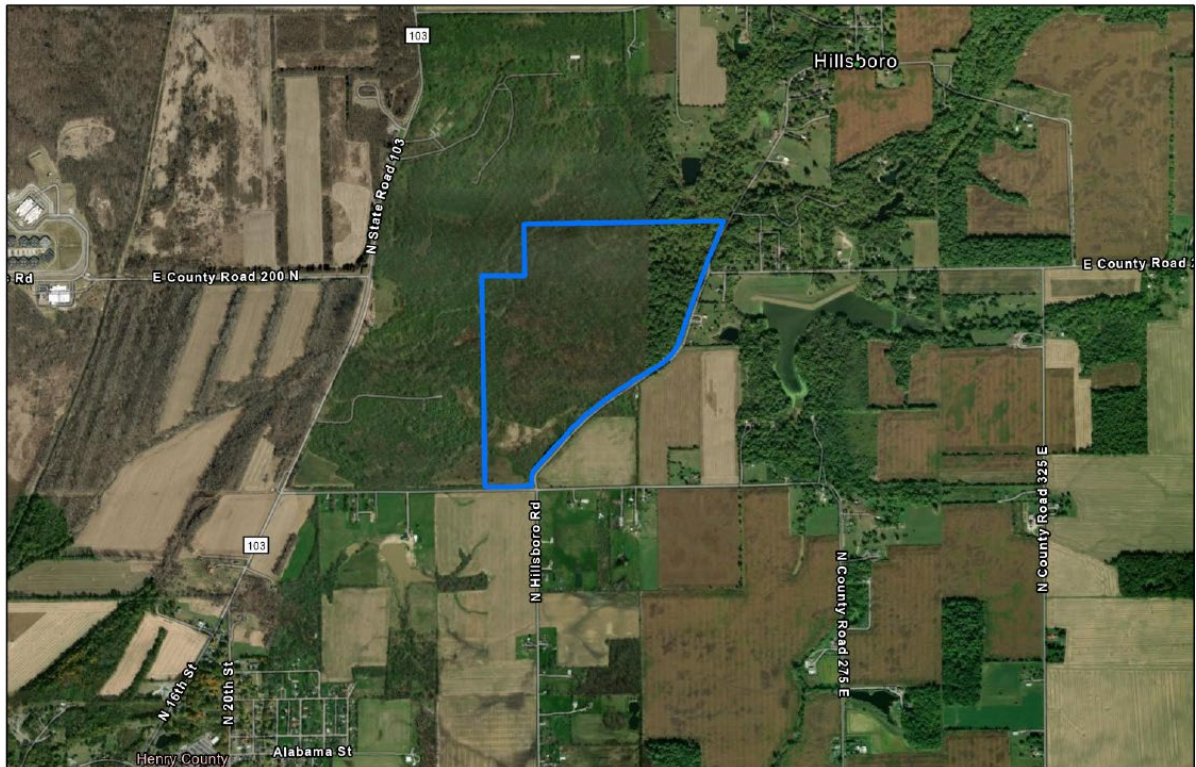
Associated species include: *Hepatica nobilis*, *Carex careyana*, and *Mitella diphylla*.

The Division of Fish, Wildlife, and Nature Preserves recommends dedication of this site as a State Nature Preserve.
