Division of Water Open House

On Sept. 4, the Division of Water held its first division-wide public open house in Alexandria, which is located in Madison County. It was the first in a series of similar events planned throughout the state. The goal is to foster cooperation with residents and local entities participating in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) while providing technical assistance and data to local officials. The initiative aligns with Senate Bill 412, passed by the Indiana legislature in 2023, which requires the department to meet with local entities at least once every five years.

The open house serves as a platform for Division of Water employees to engage directly with concerned individuals, answer their questions, and share resources. Staff members value this opportunity to step away from their computers and interact with stakeholders, demonstrating how their work protects people, property, and water resources across the state.

The event showcased various aspects of the division's work including Floodplain Management, Permitting, Engineering Services, Water Rights and Use, Water Resource Assessment, Watershed Stewardship (Conservancy Districts), and Dam and Levee Safety. In addition, division staff had a floodplain model on hand to demonstrate how various factors can impact flooding. Attendees, including elected officials, came with diverse interests; some sought answers to specific questions about their properties, while others aimed to learn more broadly about flooding and water resources in their community. Division of Water staff were on hand to address specific inquiries and general concerns, providing a comprehensive overview of their services and expertise.
