Choice Scholarship Program "F" Public School Track 2022-2023 School Year

Due to no assigned "A-F" school grades from the 2020-2021 school year, there are no "F" public schools for the "F" Public School Track to be utilized for the 2022-2023 school year.

Student must satisfy all criteria to qualify for the Choice Scholarship Program under the "F" Public School Track.

A student must:

1. Have legal settlement in Indiana;
2. Be at least five years of age and less than 22 years of age on August 1 of the school year;
3. Be required to attend a specific public school based on their residence that has been assigned an "F" grade. (This track does not require prior attendance at the school.); and
4. Be a member of a household with an annual income equal to or below 300% of the amount to qualify for the Federal Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program. (IC 20-51-1-4.3)
