## Choice Scholarship Program Pre-K Track 2022-2023 School Year

**Student must satisfy all criteria to qualify for the Choice Scholarship Program under the Pre-K Track.**

A student must:

1. Have legal settlement in Indiana;
2. Be at least five years of age and less than 22 years of age on August 1 of the school year;
3. Have received and used an Early Education Grant under IC 12-17.2-7.2 to attend pre-k at an eligible Choice Scholarship school;
4. Be applying for a Choice Scholarship at the same Choice Scholarship school they attended pre-k with an Early Education Grant; and
5. Be a member of a household with an annual income equal to or below 300% of the amount to qualify for the Federal Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program. (IC 20-51-1-4.3)
