Choice Scholarship Program

Previous SGO Track

2021-2022 School Year

Student must satisfy all criteria to qualify for the Choice Scholarship Program under the Previous SGO Track.

1. A student must:
 - a. Have legal settlement in Indiana;
 - b. Be between the ages of 5 and 22 by August 1; AND
2. A student must:
 - a. Have received a scholarship award¹ from a Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) in a previous school year, including a school year that does not immediately precede the school year for which the student is applying for a Choice Scholarship;
 - b. Have received the SGO Scholarship from one of the approved SGOs. The list of approved SGOs is posted on the website at www.doe.in.gov/Choice/school-scholarships. (*Community Foundation of Elkhart County, Institute for Quality Education, LaGrange County Community Foundation, Inc., School Scholarship Granting Organization of Northeast Indiana, Tuition Assistance Fund of Southwestern Indiana, Sagamore Institute for Education Choice, The Lutheran Scholarship Granting Organization of Indiana, and Professional Athletes of Indiana.*)

AND

3. A student must be a member of a household with an annual income equal to or below 300% of the amount to qualify for the Federal Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program. (IC 20-51-1-4.3)

¹The award must be at least five hundred dollars (\$500) in order for a student, or the student's sibling, to qualify later for a Choice Scholarship under the Previous SGO Track or Sibling Track. This rule only applies to a student or a sibling of the student who receives an SGO Award for the first time after June 30, 2013 and otherwise meets the income eligibility requirements of the program.

²Add \$25,197 for each additional family member.
