Choice Scholarship Program Sibling Track 2021-2022 School Year

Student must satisfy all criteria to qualify for the Choice Scholarship Program under the Sibling Track.

1. A student must:
 - a. Have legal settlement in Indiana;
 - b. Be between the ages of 5 and 22 by August 1;

AND

2. A student must:
 - a. Have a sibling who received either a Choice Scholarship or a scholarship award¹ from an approved Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) in a preceding school year, including a school year that does not immediately precede the school year for which the student is applying for a Choice Scholarship;

AND

3. A student must be a member of a household with an annual income equal to or below 300% of the amount to qualify for the Federal Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program. (IC 20-51-1-4.3)

¹The award must be at least five hundred dollars (\$500) in order for a student, or the student's sibling, to qualify later for a Choice Scholarship under the Previous SGO Track or Sibling Track. This rule only applies to a student or a sibling of the student who receives an SGO Award for the first time after June 30, 2013 and otherwise meets the income eligibility requirements of the program.
