## Choice Scholarship Program Sibling Track 2022-2023 School Year

**Student must satisfy all criteria to qualify for the Choice Scholarship Program under the Sibling Track.**

A student must:

1. Have legal settlement in Indiana;
2. Be at least five years of age and less than 22 years of age on August 1 of the school year;
3. Have a sibling who received either a Choice Scholarship or a scholarship award<sup>1</sup> from an approved Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) in a preceding school year, including a school year that does not immediately precede the school year for which the student is applying for a Choice Scholarship; and
4. Be a member of a household with an annual income equal to or below 300% of the amount to qualify for the Federal Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program. (IC 20-51-1-4.3)

<sup>1</sup>The award must be at least \$500 in order for a student, or the student's sibling, to qualify later for a Choice Scholarship under the Previous SGO Track or Sibling Track. This rule only applies to a student or a sibling of the student who receives an SGO award for the first time after June 30, 2013 and otherwise meets the income eligibility requirements of the program.
