Choice Scholarship Program Two Semesters in a Public School Track 2021-2022 School Year

Student must satisfy all criteria to qualify for the Choice Scholarship Program under the Two Semesters in a Public School Track.

1. A student must:
 - a. Have legal settlement in Indiana;
 - b. Be between the ages of 5 and 22 by August 1;

AND

2. A student must:
 - a. Have been enrolled in kindergarten through grade 12 in a public school, including a charter school, in Indiana for at least two semesters immediately preceding the first semester for which the individual receives a Choice Scholarship;

AND

3. A student must be a member of a household with an annual income equal to or below 300% of the amount to qualify for the Federal Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program. (IC 20-51-1-4.3)
