

Alternate Assessment Participation: Decision Flowchart



For students with a current Individualized Education Program (IEP) and enrolled in grades 3-12, consider the following:

- Results of individual cognitive ability tests, adaptive behavior skills assessments, achievement tests, district-wide alternate assessments, and English Learner (EL) assessments;
- Data from scientific research-based interventions, progress monitoring, informal assessments, observations, and checklists;
- Examples of curriculum, instructional objectives, and work samples from school- or community-based program;
- Present levels of academic and functional performance, goals, objectives, and post-school outcomes from the IEP and the Transition Plan
