Michael Dorn serves as the Executive Director of Safe Havens International, a non-profit school safety center. Safe Havens analysts have helped perform school security assessments for more than 6,860 K12 schools across the nation and abroad. Michael has published 27 books on school safety and his work has taken him to eleven countries in Central America, the Caribbean, Mexico, Canada, Europe, Asia, Africa, the subcontinent and the Middle East. Michael has provided post-incident assistance for 17 active shooter and targeted school shootings at U.S., Canadian and Mexican K12 schools and helped author the United States Department of Homeland Security IS360 Course on mass casualty incident prevention and preparedness for the 2013 White House School Safety Initiative. Michael’s 28th book, *Extreme Violence – Understanding and Protecting People from Active Assailants, Hate Crimes and Terrorism* is a 600-page university textbook due for publication by Cognella next year.
