According to <u>Attendance Works</u>, students are typically absent from school due to challenges within four categories: barriers to attendance, aversion to school, disengagement from school, and misconceptions about the impact of absences

Tier 3: Intensive Intervention

- Support Champions
- Case Management
- Student Attendance
- Review Board
- Non-Criminal Truancy Court
- Individual Learning/Success Plan
- Legal Intervention as Last Resort

Students Missing 20% or More

Tier 2: Early Intervention

- Address School and Community Barriers
- Individual Student Success Plan
- Mentors and Intensive Tutoring
- Check-In/Check-Out and Visits
- Small Group Interventions and Supports
- Restorative Alternatives to Discipline and Suspension

Students Missing 10% - 19%

Tier 1: Universal Prevention

- Clear and Consistent School-wide Expectations
- Celebration of Attendance and Engagement
- Personalized and Positive Communication to Families Recognition of Improvement
- Connection to a Caring Adult in the School
- Encourage Students/Families to Develop Success Plans
