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2022-2023 Indiana Teacher Compensation Report

Indiana Code (IC) 20-28-9-28 requires the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) to annually report information concerning teacher compensation.

As reported by Indiana schools, the information included in this report outlines the percentage of schools meeting the requirements set forth in IC 20-28-9-28, which includes:

- The percent and amount that each school corporation expended and the statewide total expended for teacher compensation;
- The percent and amount that each school corporation expended and statewide total expended for teacher benefits, including health, dental, life insurance, and pension benefits;
- Whether the school corporation met the teacher compensation requirement; and
- Whether the school corporation received a teacher compensation requirement waiver.

Expenditure Requirement for Full-time Teacher Salaries

As required by state law, beginning with fiscal year (FY) 2022, Indiana school corporations were required to expend an amount for full-time teacher salaries that was not less than an amount equal to 45% of state tuition support distributed to the school corporation during the fiscal year. To comply with the requirements outlined in IC 20-28-9-28, IDOE implemented new object codes and/or amended object code definitions to support schools in meeting the changes that took effect July 1, 2021, and accurately identify expenditures for full-time teacher salaries. In anticipation of additional legislative requirements surrounding the tracking of expenditures for detailed teacher benefits as well as salaries, IDOE then requested additional changes to the object codes as well as additional subcategories. The substantial changes to the Chart of Accounts went into effect in January 2023. The changes provided for precise and differentiated tracking of salaries and benefits for an expanded number of Indiana educators.

This report outlines educator salaries and benefits expended at 290 school corporations between July 1, 2022, and June 30, 2023. As defined by state law, charter schools are excluded from the definition of school corporation and as such, IDOE excluded them from this report.

Data Used

For purposes of the 2022-2023 Teacher Compensation Report, IDOE used two data sets.

1. FY 2023 (July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023) Form 9 financial data reported by school corporations that reflected expenditures for full-time teacher salaries.

- 2. Form 9 financial data that reflected expenditures for full-time teacher benefits from January 2023 to June 2023.
- 3. A self-reported survey by school corporations of benefit expenditures for full-time teachers from July 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022.

FY 2023 Form 9 Financial Data

To fill out a Form 9, school officials file financial data, which includes, but is not limited to, revenues, expenditures, and cash balances. The data is filed in six-month increments and includes financial information for all state, local, and federal funds. Changes necessary to modify existing or add new object codes were requested by IDOE in summer 2021. In order to accurately track teacher benefits as well as additional positions included in the definition of teachers, IDOE requested modifications to the chart of accounts again in January 2023.

The two subcategories in bold were added to the Chart of Accounts effective July 1, 2023, for teacher compensation reporting requirements beginning in FY 2024.

Self-reported Survey of Benefits Expended for Full-time Teachers

IDOE released a survey for school corporations to provide amounts expended for full-time teacher benefits during the period of July 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022. The benefits breakdown was broken into two columns representing state/local and federal expenditure amounts. There were 22 general benefit types, including social security, group health, life, dental, and vision. School corporations also had the ability to add benefits not listed in the survey. Benefit data for January 1, 2023, through June 30,

2023, was collected through the Link Portal - Form 9 data submission. Survey results can be found in Appendix B.

Methodology

For the following statistics, "per student" means the average of the fall and spring Average Daily Membership (ADM) counts. The category of "Large Size" school equates to the top quartile based on the number of students. "Mid Size" includes the middle two quartiles of students, and "Small Size" includes the bottom quartile. Demographics including Metropolitan, Rural, Suburban, and Town are based on historical categorizations. See Appendix D for classification by school corporation.

Total percent of expenditures for full-time teacher salaries were based on Form 9 expenditures for FY 2023 and were determined as follows:

<u>Numerator</u>: [(Object 110 full-time teacher salaries + Object 111 temporary teacher salaries, from July 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022) + (Object 110 and Subcategories 30-33, from January 1, 2023, through June 30, 2023)]

divided by

<u>Denominator</u>: [total state tuition support amount on the June 2023 Form 54 monthly distribution report]

The numerator includes the referenced object codes from all school corporation funds. State tuition support includes the basic grant, the special education grant, the career and technical education grant, and the honors grant. Since state tuition support for Indianapolis Public Schools includes several innovation network charter schools whose Form 9 financial data is reported separately, the amount of state tuition support was reduced proportionately for Indianapolis Public Schools. Expenditure data used in this report is based on Form 9 financial information submitted as of Friday, October 13.

The definition of the full-time teacher salary expenditure requirement was amended in July 2022 to include a proportionate share of expenditures for full-time teacher salaries made by a cooperative with the full-time teacher expenditures reported by a school corporation. The language excluded full-time teacher salaries expended by school corporations that participated in an interlocal, joint service, education service center, or shared-service agreements.

As defined in IC 20-18-2-22 (d), "full-time teacher" means "An individual licensed under IC 20-28-5 who has entered into a regular teacher's contract under IC 20-28-6-5 with a school corporation and whose primary responsibility is the instruction of students. An individual's primary responsibility is the instruction of students if the individual provides instruction to students in a classroom setting for at least fifty percent (50%) of the individual's workday. The individual's workday is the number of hours the individual is expected to work each day under the terms of the individual's contract with the school

corporation. This applies to full-time teachers." As defined, this term does not include some employees who are typically members of teacher collective bargaining, including counselors, psychologists, speech therapists, media center specialists, and others.

Salaries

Salaries: The percent and amount that each school corporation expended and the statewide total expended for full-time teacher salaries

Appendix A provides details on the percent and amount each school corporation expended for full-time teacher salaries as well as the statewide total. Using Form 9 financial data for FY 2023, the statewide total was \$3,534,132,281.64, which was 47.31% of the total tuition support amount for the same period. In FY 2022, the statewide total was \$3,415,966,090.52, which was 47.65% of the total tuition support amount for the period. The statewide median salaries as a percent of state tuition support increased from 45.75% in FY 2022 to 46.44% in FY 2023.

Four school corporations spent less than 30% of state tuition support on full-time teacher salaries. The two smallest percentages were attributable to high virtual student populations in both Clarksville Community School Corporation and Union School Corporation with virtual instruction provided by a vendor. Both districts use a contractor to provide those educational services and the contractual amount was not classified as full-time teacher salary and therefore excluded from the calculation.

Of the school corporations included in the 2022-2023 Teacher Compensation Report, 13 school corporations expended between 30-39% toward full-time teacher salaries, 83 school corporations expended between 40-44% on full-time teacher salaries, 125 school corporations expended between 45-49%, 58 school corporations expended between 50-59%, and 7 school corporations spent more than 60% of tuition support on full-time teacher salaries. Overall, 190 school corporations out of 290 exceeded the 45% expenditure requirement. There were 27 school corporations within 1% of meeting this requirement and 23 school corporations within two% of the 45% amount.

As shared in the FY 2022 report, West Central School Corporation and DeKalb Co. Eastern Community School District remain outliers because of their high percentage of full-time teacher salaries. Both school corporations serve as the lead for a local education agency (LEA) based cooperative, therefore, their expenditures reflect expenditures for full-time teacher salaries based at the cooperative as well as at the school corporation.

Overview: Demographics

As represented in Chart 1D below, the statewide median of teacher salaries per student was \$3,603.77 for all funds, up from \$3,388.22 during FY 2022, an increase of \$215.55. Metropolitan school districts had the highest median of state and local salaries per

student at \$3,826.90 in FY 2023, up from \$3,711.50 in FY 2022. The biggest change from FY 2022 to FY 2023 was the median of teacher salaries per student was in suburban school districts, which increased almost 7%, an increase of over \$230 per student.





Chart 2D below depicts the median teacher salaries as a percentage of state tuition support for all funds. The statewide median of all funds for full-time teacher salaries as a percentage of state tuition support was 46.44%, which was an increase over last year's 45.75%. The range among the various classifications this year was 45.65% to 46.51%, which represented a smaller span than in FY 2022. The lower percentage was in towns while the top end of the scale was in the rural area, which is a shift from last year, where metropolitan school corporations were higher.



Overview: Size

In Chart 1S below, large size school corporations had the highest median amount of state and local salaries per student at \$3,656.70, while small size school corporations were slightly behind at \$3,648.01 per student. Overall, the statewide median of salaries for all funds was \$3,603.77 and the trend based on size increased for each category.





Chart 2S below shows the statewide median of all funds for full-time teacher salaries as a percentage of state tuition support for FY 2023 as 46.44%. The range between small size, midsize, and large size school corporations was 46% to 46.9% with large size school corporations on the higher end and mid size school corporations on the lower end but the overall range between various sizes was less than 1%.



Waiver Appeals

School Corporations that Requested a Waiver

School corporations that determined they could not comply with the 45% full-time teacher salary expenditure requirement could apply for a waiver from IDOE. IDOE developed a waiver application which included additional documentation that would be helpful to support a school corporation's request for waiver from the 45% expenditure requirement. Waiver information used in this report is based on requests submitted as of Friday, October 13. Additional documentation requested from school corporations included, but was not limited to the following:

- Five-year history of school facilities, including any added or closed school buildings.
- Information concerning the financial challenges currently facing the school corporation.

- Documentation concerning innovative or efficient approaches in delivering instruction that is responsible for the school corporation being unable to meet the expenditure requirement.
- Cost saving measures taken by the school corporation in attempting to meet the requirement.
- Other steps taken by the school corporation in attempting to meet the requirement.
- Other documentation may include:
 - Ending cash balances for all funds.
 - o Projected fund balances moving forward.
 - Other financial information.
 - o Recent trends in ADM.
 - Outstanding debt.
 - Deferred capital projects.
 - Status of any current or future referendums.
 - Implementation of other measures referenced in the <u>Roadmap for Improving Indiana Teacher Compensation (Next Level Teacher Compensation Commission Report)</u>

Appendix A provides a list of all school corporations, the percentage of expenditures in FY 2023 for full-time teacher salaries, which school corporations filed a waiver, and whether those waivers were approved or denied. For FY 2023, nine school corporations filed a waiver request, and all were approved.

As part of its review process, IDOE could approve a one-year exception to the waiver requirement for school corporations that exhausted reasonable efforts in attempting to meet the 45% expenditure amount. School corporations receiving a waiver from the 45% expenditure requirement must work with IDOE to develop a plan to identify additional cost saving measures and any other steps that would allow the school corporation to meet the requirement in the future. As outlined in state law, IDOE may not grant more than three waivers to a school corporation.

Benefits

Percent and Amount Expended by Each School Corporation and Statewide

Beginning in January 2023, Form 9 financial data reflected the level of detail needed to determine the amount expended for full-time teacher benefits. In order to capture benefit data from July through December 2022, the following survey was distributed to school corporations to determine expenditures for full-time teacher benefits. Benefit expenditures from January to June 2023 were pulled by IDOE from Form 9 financial data reported by school corporations.

All 290 school corporations completed the full-time teacher benefit survey. Because some teachers perform additional duties outside their normal teaching responsibilities, IDOE did not request that school corporations break-out benefits for a full-time teacher who also received additional compensation. For example, benefits were not separated into different categories for a teacher who was compensated as a full-time teacher during the school year and who also received additional compensation for serving as a teacher in a summer-school program.

Survey results combined with Form 9 financial data can be found in Appendix B. The statewide median full-time teacher benefits as a percentage of state tuition support was 15.82%. Statewide total expenditures from all funds for full-time teacher benefits were \$1,283,021,616.14 for all reported categories. This is an increase over last year's reported total benefits amount which was \$1,227,566,095. As shown in Table 1B, this represents 17% of the \$7,469,677,860 in state tuition support received by the 290 school corporations. Insurance benefits, at 8.56%, continued to slightly outpace salary and retirement benefits, which were at 8.38% in FY 2023. Other benefits were less than 1% of state tuition support.

Statewide, teacher retirement and social security expenditures represent the majority of expenditures for salary/retirement benefits, for which all schools reflected expenditures. Only three school corporations reported expenditures under the Public Employees Retirement Fund - Optional Contribution. For FY 2023, the median cost per student for the Teacher Retirement Fund was \$286.73 and the median cost per student for Social Security was \$269.18.

As illustrated in Table 2B, both Teacher Retirement Fund and Social Security had an increase in the cost per student in FY 2023 when compared to FY 2022. From FY 2022 to FY 2023, there was a small decrease in the median cost per student for Public Employees Retirement fund and Public Employees Retirement Fund-Optional

Contributions. With the exception of the Social Security and Teacher Retirement Fund, all areas experienced a decrease in the median cost per student from FY 2022 to FY 2023.

Insurance Benefits

As Chart 3B shows, Group Health Insurance represented the largest portion of expenditures for full-time teacher insurance benefits. Health Savings Account or VEBA Contributions were next followed by expenditures for Dental Insurance. Overall insurance expenditures increased from \$629,406,507.21 in FY 2022 to \$645,759,724.12 in FY 2023. Insurance benefit areas that experienced an increase in the median cost per student were Group Life Insurance, Group Accident Insurance, Other Group Insurance, and Unemployment Insurance. The number of school corporations participating in one or more benefit programs increased from FY 2022 to FY 2023.

Other Benefits

Other benefits, as outlined in Table 4B below, reflect the smallest share of total benefits reported. Other benefits are offered at the discretion of the school governing body with the largest median cost per student amount in the Other Benefits categories not specified in the survey. These include tuition reimbursement, food service staff meals, and entertainment.

Additional points regarding the benefits survey include:


- Health and dental benefits were combined for some school corporations that could not delineate the costs.
- Benefits for some full-time teachers may reflect more than one position held by the teacher (i.e. full-time teacher who also serves as a part-time coach might have adjustments for social security and other benefits associated with each role).

Salaries and Benefits Combined

Percent and Amount Expended by School Corporation and Statewide

Statewide expenditures from all funds for full-time teacher salaries and benefits together totaled \$4,817,153,897.78, reflecting a 3.74% increase over the FY 2022 reported total of \$4,643,274,725.77 (See Appendix C). Comparing full-time teacher salary and benefits amount to the amount of state tuition support, the percentages ranged from 13.16% to 117.47% with a median value of 62.03% of tuition support. Outliers exist on both ends of the range as discussed earlier in the report.

Chart 1B below shows the ranges of salaries and benefits for full-time teachers to the amount of tuition support for all funds, with the largest number of school corporations falling between the range of 60-65% range. There were 58 school corporations in the 56-59% range, 37 school corporations falling in the 66-69% range, and 27 school corporations expending more than 75% of tuition support on full-time teacher salaries and benefits.



Legislative Updates

During the 2023 legislative session, House Enrolled Act (HEA) 1001-2023 further amended teacher compensation expenditure requirements. Effective July 1, 2023, the teacher compensation expenditure requirement increased from 45% to 62% of state tuition support distributed to each school corporation. Additionally, "full-time teacher salaries" was replaced with the term "teacher compensation" to reflect both salaries and benefits, which will be collected through Form 9 financial data. Teacher compensation includes all of the salary and benefits object codes 100 to 299 for both full-time and part-time teachers, including Terminal Leave, Overtime, and Additional Compensation for FY 2024 and beyond. Teacher compensation as outlined by IC 20-18-2-22 also includes expenditures for adjunct teachers, supplemental pay for teachers, stipends. Further, also included in teacher compensation is the prorated share of teacher salaries and benefits attributable for participating in a special education cooperative, interlocal agreement or consortium that is directly attributable to compensating teachers employed by the cooperative, interlocal, or consortium.

To properly code expenditures captured as part of the 62% requirement, school corporations are required to use Object Codes 100-299 and Subcategories 30-39 and 62-67 for total compensation. The calculated percentage for FY 2024 will be based on

total expenditures from the aforementioned Object Codes and Subcategories divided by total state tuition support (all grants).

Additionally, 42 school corporations filed a prospective waiver for the 62% requirement because officials do not believe they can meet the new requirement for the fiscal year 2023-2024. All 42 waiver requests have been approved. IDOE will be completing a comparison of waiver applications to actual expenditures in fall 2024, prior to submitting the 2023-2024 Teacher Compensation Report.Included in Appendix A is a list of school corporations that prospectively filed for a waiver for the 2023-2024 school year.

Summary

For the 2022-2023 Teacher Compensation report, the full-time teacher salary expenditure requirement was amended in July 2022 to include a proportionate share of expenditures for full-time teacher salaries made by a cooperative with the full-time teacher expenditures reported by a school corporation. The expanded language provided for school corporations to include a proportionate share of expenditures for full-time teachers employed by a cooperative.

Although the 45% expenditure requirement was in place for FY 2022 and FY 2023, the expansion in language between the two years resulted in an overall increase in expenditures from one year to the next. This change recognized the importance of cost-saving measures and collaborative efforts between school corporations and the cooperatives in which they participate. Further the amended language recognizes each school corporation's need to balance programs and services with available funds and takes into account various options considered by a school governing body to adequately fund those programs and services.

Moving the requirement to 62% of *all* salaries and benefits, teacher compensation further allows school corporations and local governing bodies to find the appropriate balance of salaries and benefits that best serves their needs and supports academic success for Indiana students.
