Updated 8/26/19: In response to educator feedback, numeric values representing the highest obtainable scale score (HOSS) and lowest obtainable scaled score (LOSS) for each tested grade-level test are now located in the table, below.

The Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) completed a research-based methodology to recommend the following performance level cut scores for the ILEARN assessment. Over 100 educators collaborated across nine grade-level committee groups to formalize these recommendations based on the content and rigor defined in the Indiana Academic Standards. Additionally, IDOE convened a policy committee from the initiation of the ILEARN work to review and inform larger perspectives. The policy committee supported the following recommendations from the educator panel.

The Indiana State Board of Education approved as final the educators' cut score recommendations on July 25, 2019:
