The Region 2 Migrant Education Program has been awarded the IDOE R.E.A.C.H grant that will provide after school programming for migrant students for two days a week each at the Logansport Community School Corporation in Logansport IN and Washington Community Schools in Washington, IN during the school year. Our R.E.A.C.H. program will address service gaps relating to academic needs and social emotional needs. To address the academic gaps of service, a dedicated time for instruction aimed to enrich academic curriculum and target skills needing more support will occur each day. This instruction may be small group or individualized depending on current needs of the group and continually transforms as group needs and dynamics change. The large service gap with social emotional needs will be met through implementation of enrichment programming in fine arts, healthy living and fitness, STEM, growth mindset, and emotional well-being. Offering high quality out-of-school time programming near students during the regular school year will afford the best prospect to increase achievement for migrant students. During the regular school year, after-school programming will occur for 2.5 hours each day.
