Subject: 2025 Individual Reading Plan Guidance and Template

<u>Indiana Code (IC) 20-30-7-13(d)</u> requires all schools to provide summer school programming for students who need additional reading support – specifically, grade two students at risk of not being proficient and grade three who are not proficient in reading, as determined by the IREAD assessment. Students who attend less than 90% of the summer program must have an individual reading plan for the following school year, aligned with science of reading.

The individual reading plan may include, but is not limited to, the information below:

- 1. Student data:
- 2. Specific area(s) of need;
- 3. Intervention Plan, including history of interventions used previously;
- 4. Progress monitoring tracker;
- 5. Parent communication log; and
- 6. Additional resources used for support.
