



2022-2023 INDIANA SAT ACCOMMODATIONS CROSSWALK

The **SAT Accommodations Crosswalk** has been designed to help educators understand the relationship between the College Board options in Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD) Online, the SAT accommodation options listed in Indiana IEP (IIEP), and related daily accommodations. Although the Indiana SAT is administered digitally, SSD Online is aligned to paper-based College Board assessments; therefore, additional notes regarding how students will test digitally are included. The paper-based SAT is only allowed for students that require a paper assessment accommodation as documented in their formal plan.
