



2024-2025 INDIANA SAT ACCOMMODATIONS CROSSWALK

The **Indiana SAT Accommodations Crosswalk** helps educators understand the relationship between the College Board options in Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD) Online, the SAT accommodation options listed in Indiana IEP (IIEP), and related daily accommodations. SSD Online accommodations automatically transfer to Test Day Toolkit (TDTK) and Bluebook. The paper-based SAT is only allowed for students that require a paper assessment accommodation. 
