Subject: Request for Indiana State Board of Eduction Hearing (IC 20-26-11-5)

The Indiana State Board of Education has the authority to hear disputes on expulsion due to lack of legal settlement, right to attend school, the amount of transfer tuition due and any other matters arising under law and giving the Board jurisdiction. Briefly state the facts and request that the State Board of Education determine the student's right to attend school in a particular school corporation, the student's legal settlement, or the amount of transfer tuition. The appeal can be sent by letter, fax, or email.

Upon receipt of the letter or email, a Hearing Examiner will be assigned to the appeal on behalf of the State Board. Please be advised that the process is not quick. The Indiana General Assembly has enacted laws that govern these proceedings. The laws include timelines and notice requirements. In most cases it takes several months to enter a final decision.
