Finding 10140: Wellness Policy Review and Update

The following findings were noted regarding the review and update of the local school wellness policy:

- a) The results of the most recent assessment of the local school wellness policy are not available to the public.
- b) While the Wellness Committee met, policy language is not being adhered to or is out of date to school's procedures.

Corrective Action: As corrective action the following must occur:

- a) The local school wellness policy must be reviewed and updated by the wellness committee. A copy of the assessment and updated wellness policy must be submitted to the State Agency.
- b) The LEA must permit participation by the public and the school community in the review and update of the wellness policy. The policy must be re-assessed with input from all interested stakeholders as through the wellness committee.
 - 1) Provide documentation of notification used to inform households of the re-assessment of the local school wellness policy.
 - 2) Once the re-assessment occurs, provide documentation of the assessment.
 - 3) Provide proof that the results of the most recent assessment have been communicated to the public, including progress toward meeting the goals of the policy.

Corrective Action: For corrective action, complete the following:

- 1) Review the SFA's Food Safety Plan
- 2) Take the ICN training on Intro to HACCP
- 3) Upload certificate of completion.
- 4) Update the Food Safety plan to include all missing elements (HACCP, CCP, written SOP's, temp logs, and process approach).
- 5) Upload the updated Food Safety Plan.
