# Finding 9117: Unallowable general expenses charged to the nonprofit school food service account.

Based on the SFA's accounting records for the most recently completed PY 2024, general expenses charged to the nonprofit school foodservice account were not reasonable, necessary and/or allocable. Unallowable expenses, purpose of expenditures and amounts: The FSMC included the expense of a bonus for the FSMC manager which totaled \$6,101.69. This was paid out of the non-profit food service account; however, it is an unallowable expenditure.

### **Corrective Action:**

The unallowable charges must be restored to the account by the FSMC as it was billed without consideration of regulatory requirements. Provide proof of the full restoration of funds to the state agency for corrective action.

## Finding 10126: Professional Standards Training Requirements and Documentation

Training for all food service staff is not being routinely and sufficiently tracked. Documentation of training has been an annual requirement since the Professional Standards requirements since at least 2017.

#### **Corrective Action:**

Annual training for all staff with food service responsibilities is a program requirement. As corrective action, provide the state agency with an updated professional standards tracker for the current program year.

# **Technical Assistance:**

Any training completed should have a dated agenda, topics discussed, and staff signatures. If handouts are provided during the trainings, copies should be maintained with the training documentation. As corrective action a physical copy of a site-specific food safety plan must be made available for each site. Confirm the date that the food safety plan was provided to the site.

1409. On-site or off-site storage violations were observed

#### **Technical Assistance- Storage**

At Three Creeks, the milk crates were stored on the ground with milk cartons inside. The health department did not write them up for this, but the state agency is recommending that empty milk crates be placed on the ground first before the milk crates with milk cartons.

1411. Review of agricultural food components indicates violations of the Buy American provision
