Meal Components & Quantities - Carroll Jr.-Sr. High School (0621)

402. Day of Review- the minimum daily quantity requirements are met for the age/grade group being served

Finding 9000: Portion size unable to be determined

On the day of review, the cafeteria staff used serving spoons and tongs to serve three components. By using non-measurable serving utensils, staff are unable to ensure students are receiving full component sizes or what is necessary for a reimbursable meal.

Corrective Action:

The SA provided technical assistance while on-site and the SFA was able to replace the serving utensils with measurable utensils. No further action required.

409. Review Period- all required meal components per weekly meal pattern requirements were offered and served to students

Finding 9000: Standardized Recipes

Standardized recipes did not include crediting information. Each recipe should list the serving size and how it contributes to the meal pattern requirements.

Corrective Action:

The SFA has already determined crediting information for each recipe. They will simply add it to the standardized recipe so that all required information is in one location. No further action required.

General Program Compliance - Carroll Jr.-Sr. High School (0621)

1405. Two food safety inspections are received each school year from the local health department

Technical Assistance

When the SFA contacts the health department to notify them of their intent to operate during scheduled school year, they must also request they inspect their kitchens twice per school year per child nutrition program requirements.
