## **Certification and Benefit Issuance - Corpus Christi School (K271)**

128. Correct conversion factors used for applications with more than one income frequency?

## Finding 9019: Incorrect conversion factors used when processing applications. \*Repeat Finding

For applications that indicate more than one income frequency, the SFA did not use the correct conversion factors to determine monthly household income: weekly – times 52; bi-weekly – times 26; twice per month – 24; and monthly – times 12.

#### **Corrective Action:**

At the time of the onsite review, the determining official updated all applications to reflect the correct conversion factors. The Determining Official will begin converting only to an annual figure when needed. No further action required.

139. Manual Systems – Update student eligibility/enrollment on paper sheets/rosters?

Finding 9000: Technical Assistance- Benefit Effective Dates

### **Technical Assistance:**

The reviewer provided onsite technical assistance on the electronic Benefit Issuance Document (BID). Effective dates should be included on all student benefits; this information needs to be added manually to BID.

767. Nonprogram Revenue and Food Cost Ratio

Finding 9000: Non-Program Foods

### **Technical Assistance:**

The reviewer provided onsite technical assistance on how to track both program and non-program revenues and costs. After completion of the non-program tool, the cost and revenue ratios are close to breakeven. It is suggested that a slight price increase occur on some of the non-program foods being sold.

810. Non-discrimination on appropriate Program materials?

#### Finding 9000: Non-Discrimination Statement \*Repeat Finding

Program Materials include an outdated Non-Discrimination statement. The school website does not have the Non-Discrimination statement posted.

#### **Corrective Action:**

At the review, the Principal had the technology department update the school website to include the Full Non-Discrimination

statement from USDA. The Food Service Director updated program materials to the most current statement from USDA. The reviewer validated the website and program materials during the onsite review. No further action required.

Finding 9000: Outreach Documentation of Wellness Policy

#### **Technical Assistance:**

The reviewer and Principal discussed ways to document community outreach and/or involvement of the Local School Wellness Policy.

1400. Food safety plan – contain required elements, copy available at each school?

Finding 9000: Food Safety Plan

#### **Technical Assistance:**

The Food Safety Plan should be reviewed yearly. The current Food Safety plan has been implemented, however, has not been reviewed since 2014. The reviewer did observe proper food storage and safe food handling practices including taking/recording of temperatures.
