Technical Assistance

- * The share table food items must not be given away to teachers. The food is for children only and cannot be given to adults under any circumstances. The share table food can be refrigerated properly and offered to students for the next meal service.
- * It is recommended to purchase a healthy tomato soup option.
- * Offering additional food options for students is recommended to encourage all students to eat and increase participation. Ample choices offered will reduce limitations for students.
- * A refresher on OVS is encouraged to ensure food service staff are fully understanding what makes a reimbursable meal.

Meal Components & Quantities - Edinburgh Middle/High School (3447)

410. Review Period- planned menu quantities meet the meal pattern requirements

Finding 9076: Planned menus served during Review month do not meet portion size/quantity requirements.

Productions records were reviewed for the Review Period to determine whether the portion sizes of meal components from the planned menu and served during the Review Period meet the minimum meal pattern requirements for the 9-12 grades group being served. Meals served with insufficient portion size or insufficient quantities of meal components are incomplete and are not reimbursable.

The tortilla shell for the chicken fajita met 1.5 ounces equivalency for grains and not the required 2 ounces equivalency of grains.

Corrective Action:

The Cafeteria Manager stated that they will purchase a tortilla shell that meets the 2-ounce equivalency for grains. If this corrective action is taken as discussed, no further action is necessary.

Technical Assistance:

The school was provided technical assistance during the on-site visit.
