Finding 9011: Local School Wellness Policy information on the Off-site Assessment Tool not validated, or deficiencies found.

Some of the information gathered on the Off-site Assessment Tool regarding the SFA's Local School Wellness Policy could not be validated during on-site observations. Deficiencies found on-site: The Wellness Policy does not have language explaining the marketing requirements.

Corrective Action:

Corrective action required to address discrepancies or deficiencies in the SFA's Local School Wellness Policy identified from the Off-site Assessment Tool: The Wellness Policy is to be updated to include all the required items.

Discussed with Food service Director that when planning different serving sizes for elementary and middle school, separate Meal certification worksheets must be completed for each age group. A separate sheet was sent the next day.

409. Review Period- all required meal components per weekly meal pattern requirements were offered and served to students

Finding 9075: Production records/supporting documentation indicate weekly meal pattern requirements for the age/grade group(s) not met.

Based on a review of production records and other supporting food crediting documentation for 1 week during the Review Period February 3-7, one product did not have appropriate crediting documentation.

Corrective Action:

Staff determined a different product to serve. No further action required.

Technical Assistance:

The school was provided technical assistance during the on-site visit.

General Program Compliance - Millersburg Elementary Middle School (1621)

1409. On-site or off-site storage violations were observed

Finding 9150: Storage violations were observed.

The SFA must ensure that all of its facilities for the handling, storage, and distribution of purchased and donated foods are properly safeguarded against theft, spoilage, and other loss. Temperature is not appropriately maintained for walk in cooler.

Corrective Action:

Food Service Director contacted maintenance and correction was made on-site. No further action required.
