Finding 9000: Food Production Records

The SFA has vended meals and completes a daily meal count log. This log only documents the total number of meals - it does not contain each item that is served daily. The meals are unitized and contain all the same components, but a food production record is still required.

Corrective Action:

The SFA and State Agency have discussed that all items need to be included on the food production record and they have been provided with the state agency's FPR. No further action is necessary.
