Meal Components & Quantities - North Madison Elementary School (6385)

409. Review Period- all required meal components per weekly meal pattern requirements were offered and served to students

Finding 9075: Production records/supporting documentation indicate weekly meal pattern requirements for the age/grade group(s) not met.

Based on a review of production records and other supporting food crediting documentation for 1 week during the Review Period January 13-17, 2020, some meals served during the week reviewed did not meet the appropriate daily and weekly meal pattern requirements for the age/grade group(s) being served. Due to planned changes to the menu, the weekly quantity requirement for dark green vegetables was not met. This is not a repeat finding.

Corrective Action:

The menu planner is well aware of the mistake made- the original menu did meet all requirements. No further action required.
