Commendations

- * The Food Service Director and Cafeteria Manager were prepared and organized for the Administrative Review. It is obvious that the staff want to run a compliant program and are eager to learn. The staff works well as a team and interact with the students.

Technical Assistance

- * The reviewer provided the link to the Grain Chart for the cafeteria manager to ensure the crediting amount for grains.
- * There is breakfast signage for offer vs serve, but it would be best to have one for each serving line.
- * It was suggested by the reviewer to have offer vs serve at least the second graders because of the amount of food that goes to the share table daily.
- * Although the triennial assessment for the Wellness Policy was waived for this school year, the reviewer sent the IDOE link for completing it in the near future.
- * An application with a zero income would be considered complete, and it is recommended to verify it for cause.
- * The reviewer suggested using the 1/2 cup measure and heaping the tator tots instead of counting 12 on each plate. The foodservice staff liked the suggestion.
- * Applications must be complete, including the signature of the household and social security number before approving them.

410. Review Period- planned menu quantities meet the meal pattern requirements

Finding 9076: Planned menus served during Review month do not meet portion size/quantity requirements.

Productions records were reviewed for the Review Period to determine whether the portion sizes of meal components from the planned menu and served during the Review Period meet the minimum meal pattern requirements for the K-8 age/grade group(s) being served. Meals served with insufficient portion size or insufficient quantities of meal components are incomplete and are not reimbursable. The menu planner is reminded to plan menus that meet all components in both the daily and weekly serving sizes.

Corrective Action:

The Uncrustable provided 1 oz of meat/meat alternate and 1 oz equivalency for grain which is served daily for the month of review. The cafeteria manager added 1 oz string cheese and 1 bag of goldfish to complete the meal for today and explained the plan to the foodservice staff. No further action is needed.

The school was provided technical assistance during the on-site visit.
