Meal Components & Quantities - St Rose of Lima School (B518)

401. Day of Review- all meals observed and counted for reimbursement contained all of the required meal components

Finding 9000: Other Finding

Two lunches counted for reimbursement did not contain 1/2 cup fruit/vegetable. This contributed toward fiscal action calculations.

410. Review Period- planned menu quantities meet the meal pattern requirements

Finding 9076: Planned menus served during Review month do not meet portion size/quantity requirements.

Production records were reviewed for the Review Period to determine whether the portion sizes of meal components from the planned menu and served during the Review Period meet the minimum meal pattern requirements for the age/grade group(s) being served. Lunch on Monday of the Review Period only provided 1/2 cup vegetable; the Piazza delivery for the planned salad bar did not arrive on time and additional vegetable offerings were not served.

Corrective Action:

The new site manager is continuing to receive additional training on what must be served for meal pattern compliance and is learning how to troubleshoot when deliveries do not arrive as scheduled. No further action required.

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
