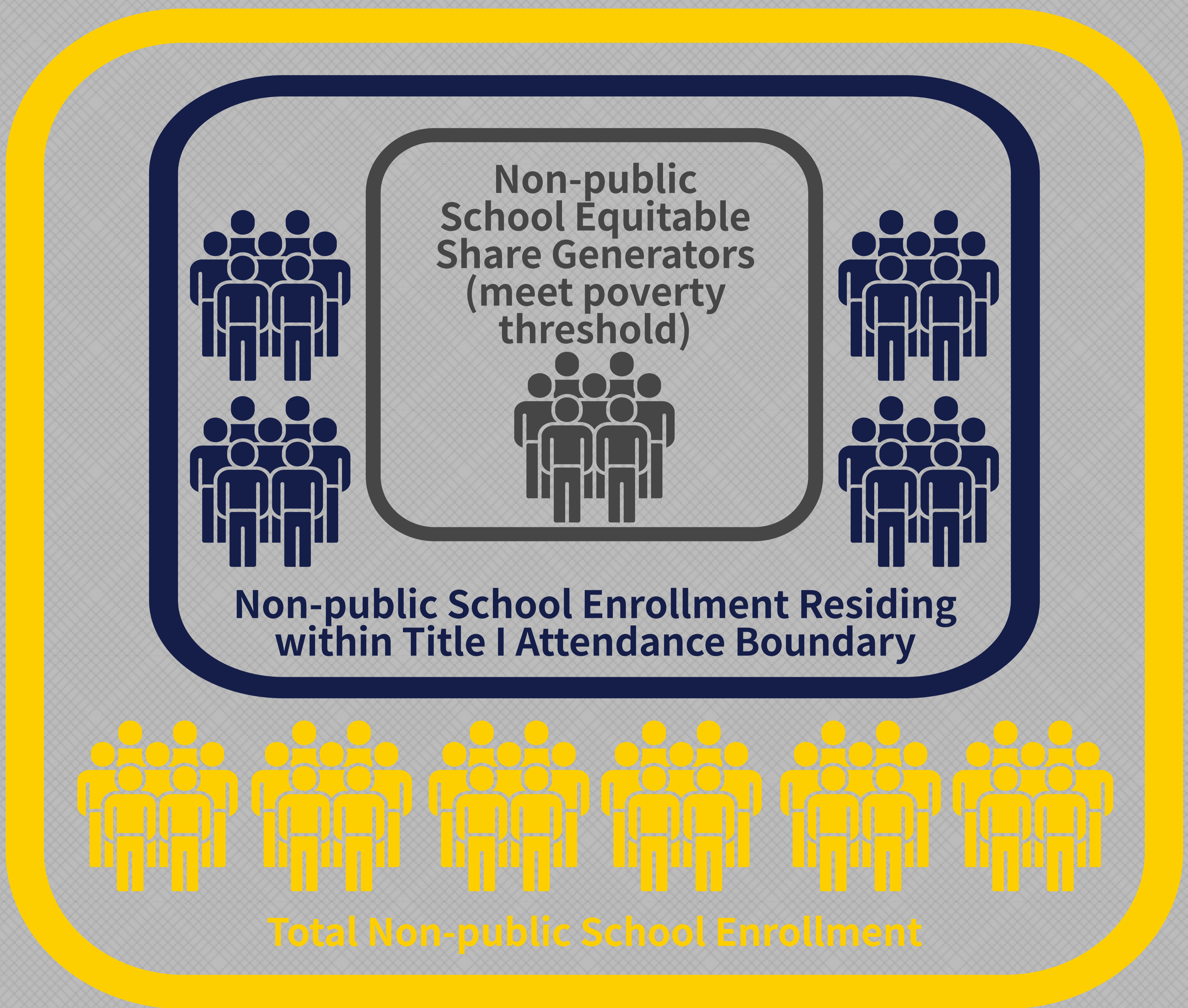




# CARES Act Eligibility and Equitable Share Calculation for Non-public Schools



**Total Non-public School (NPS) Enrollment**

**77 students**

- K-8 building
- All students eligible to receive CARES Act services

**NPS Students Residing within Title I Attendance Boundary**

**35 students**

- LEA only serves K-5 with Title I funds
- Count only students in grade span K-5 and residing within TI attendance boundary

**NPS Equitable Share Generators**

**7 students**

- From grade span and Title I attendance boundary group, count only students meeting poverty threshold

Total LEA Enrollment (K-12)	1000	Total LEA CARES Act Allocation	\$50,000
LEA Title I Served (K-5) Enrollment	500	Total Poverty (LEA + NPS)	207
LEA Title I Served w Poverty	200	Per Pupil Figure (PPF)	$\$50,000 / 207 = \$241.545894$
Total NPS Enrollment (K-8)	77	NPS CARES Act Equitable Share (PPF x TI Served w Poverty)	$\$241.545894 \times 7 = \$1690.82$
NPS Title I Served (K-5) Enrollment	35	LEA CARES Act Adjusted Allocation (Total LEA Allocation - NPS Equitable Share)	$\$50,000 - \$1690.82 = \$48,309.18$
NPS Title I Served w Poverty	7

LEA (K-12)	1000	LEA (K-12)	\$48,309.18
NPS (K-8)	77	NPS (K-8)	\$1,690.82

\*If the NPS does not have any students living within the LEA's Title I Served Attendance Boundaries, no equitable share will be generated. For example, in the above scenario, if the NPS enrolled only Gr 9-12, the NPS would not be eligible for a CARES Act Equitable Share from the LEA due to zero students meeting the Title I Served Enrollment category requirement.
